

Pentagonal Antiprism

An antiprism is like a prism in that its two end faces are identical polygons and parallel to each other but, in an antiprism, the connecting faces are all triangles rather than rectangles or parallelograms. As with a prism, it is named after the shape of the end polygon. **To make** Cut out along all the 'solid' lines. Score and crease along the 'broken' lines. Fold it up into position (without glue) so as to get an idea of how it will look. Glue tab 1 under the face with November on it. The rest should be obvious.
